BURSARY APPLICATION

Eligibility for a Legion bursary is based primarily on the student's family financial situation and the student's academic standing and contribution to student and community life. Bursaries are awarded to residents of Maple Ridge and Pitt Meadows only. Applications, including letters of reference, must be received no later than May 15, of the current year.

Complete applications must be returned to:

Other than extenuating circumstances, a Legion bursary will not be given to a student who has or will receive another award from another source. If, after accepting one of our awards, a student is offered or awarded a bursary or scholarship from another source the bursary must be returned to Branch #88.

It is the responsibility of the applicant to complete the application in full and to ensure that all related items are submitted to Branch #88 by the deadline date.

Applicants must provide the following to expedite the processing of their application.

- 1) A complete application form
- 2) Letters of reference
- 3) A statement from the student stating goals and aspirations
- 4) An official interim report card or transcript
- 5) A statement from the student outlining their goals

University students must also provide:

- 1) Transcript of marks covering two semesters, running from September of the previous year to April of the current year
- 2) Have you previously applied for a Branch #88 award? _____
- 3) Was award granted? _____ Year? _____

General information:

All applications will be considered. Preference is given to children and grandchildren of families with military affiliation.

Bursaries will be awarded to students wishing to enter university, a regional college or to attend an approved school for vocational or technical training within the province of B.C.

Bursaries may be used for tuition or books only. An acceptance letter from the school or university that you will be attending, showing your student number, is necessary for the deposit of the bursary to your student account. The onus is totally with the applicant to ensure all requirements are met
