

GUIDELINES FOR LIFE-LEASE WAITING LIST

These guidelines will take effect on October 1st, 2015. At that time the old Branch 88 waiting list for life-lease applicants will be eliminated.

Applicants from the old list who can immediately declare their ability to occupy a suite within three (3) months of the change-over will be entered on the new Waiting List in chronological order of original applications.

New applicants may enter the Waiting List immediately if they are able to occupy a suite within three (3) months.

AS WITH ALL BRANCH 88 HOUSING, A QUALIFIED VETERAN WILL BE GIVEN PRIORITY OVER ALL OTHER APPLICANTS.

To be on the Waiting List a person must be a current Legion member.

To be on the Waiting List a person must be 55 years of age or older.

For preferential reasons, a person on the Waiting List may refuse a suite one time with no change in status, but a second refusal will remove them from the Waiting List and cancel their application. They may choose to re-apply.

If no Waiting List applicant is interested in an available suite, the suite will be advertised immediately.

It is the applicant's responsibility to keep the Branch 88 Housing Committee informed of their current contact information. If we are unable to contact an applicant, his/her application will be removed from the Waiting List immediately.
